Clean the lifebuoy with fresh water and mild soap to remove dirt, salt, and algae. Rinse thoroughly to prevent any residue from causing damage. Avoid using harsh chemicals or cleaners that could degrade the material. Lifebuoy rings have a lifespan around 5-10 years, depending on usage and exposure.
