

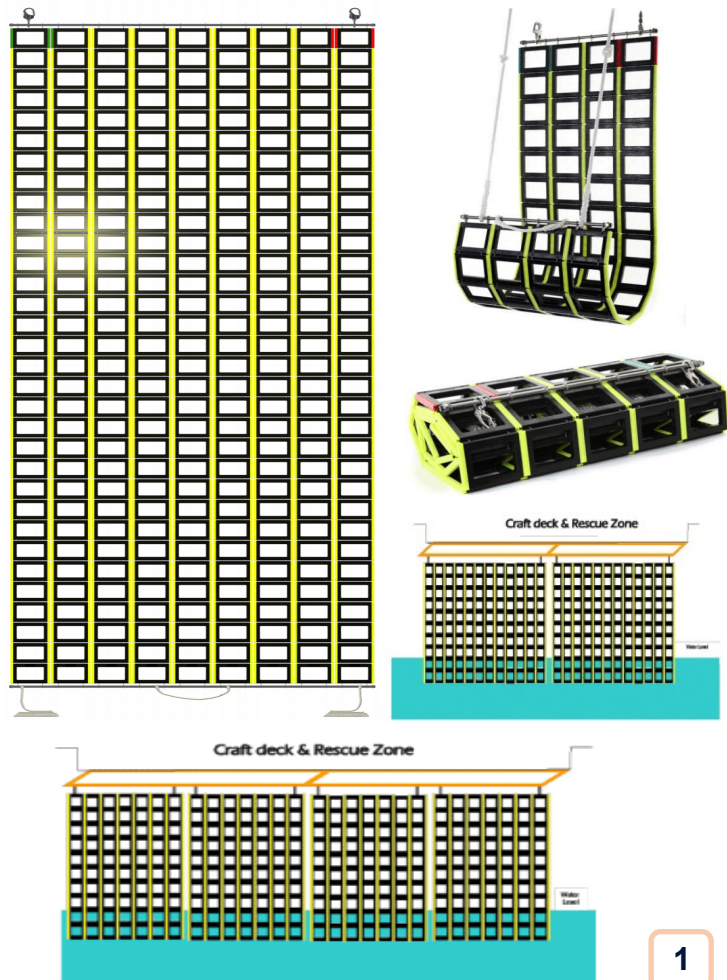

DESCRIPTION

The Jason's Cradle Scramble net is a globally used, and proven method of safe and speedy recovery from water. Casualties are retrieved in the medically preferred, horizontal position—ideal for commencing quick medical attention once the person is lifted on-board the vessel. You can fix the Scramble Net to a deck or rail, enabling rapid deployment (within seconds) and can be easily rolled up for stowage. This piece of equipment functions the same way as a standard Jason's Cradle when retrieving casualties horizontally—but, can also be climbed by able-bodied personnel / rescuers who may have entered the water during rescue. Multiple units can be positioned to achieve larger rescue zones. Whilst also facilitating mass disembarking for large numbers of passengers / crew during emergency events.
