The SB Rescue Sling Matesaver is quick and easy to use, allows safe one-person operation from vessel or shore, and fast distance recovery without the rescuer entering the water.

SB Rescue Sling Frame

The SB Rescue Sling Frame, made from anodised aluminium and measuring 1.2 m, easily clicks onto the pole of the MOB system, and the SB Rescue Harness can be quickly attached to the frame using the black clips. The frame should be replaced 9 years after its issue date.



SB Line Bag & Carabiner

The SB Rescue Line is a 6m x 12mm polyester plaited line, designed for use with the SB Rescue Sling man overboard system. The line can be stored in the SB Line Bag for safe keeping and allows quick, effective deployment during a rescue using the bag and line mechanism.



SB Rescue Harness

The SB Rescue Harness is made for the SB Rescue Sling man overboard system and lasts three years, with each harness having a unique serial number. It can hold up to 500 kg and attaches quickly to the frame using black clips and the included six-meter line with carabiner. Lightweight and easy to use, it fits securely for fast, safe recovery.



SB 1m Handle Extension

The SB Rescue Handle Extension is a 1 m telescopic addition for the SB Rescue Sling man overboard system, extending the total pole length to 5.2 m for safe and effective recovery from a distance.



SB Telescopic Boat Hook

The Telescopic Boat Hook extends from 1.7m to 3m and is used alongside the SB Rescue Sling man overboard system. Additional 1m Extension option available for increased reachable length. Giving the user a fully extended length of 4m.

The SB Rescue Sling provides a complete man-overboard solution, fully set up and ready to use. The telescopic pole reaches the casualty safely from a distance, while the SB Rescue Sling Frame and harness secure and lift them out of the water.

The SB Rescue Line, stored in the SB Line Bag, guides and controls the casualty, and the 1 m Handle Extension adds extra reach when needed. The system enables fast, efficient rescues and resets in under 30 seconds for repeated use.

SB Rescue Davit

The SB Rescue Davit is a telescopic, manually operated davit designed to work with the SB Rescue Sling man overboard system. It enables fast, safe, and efficient recovery, overcoming challenges during rescue like high freeboard, rescuer fatigue, and limited crews. Like the SB Rescue Sling, the SB Davit can be easily operated by a single person.

SB MOB Cradle Recovery Pole

The Cradle Recovery Pole extends from 1.73 m to 4.73 m and works with all marine recovery cradles. But can be utilised as a stand-alone body recovery pole. One end has a loop-style body hook for guiding a person into a cradle, the other a smaller boat-hook for netting. Hi-vis tape and a locking clamp make it safe and easy to use, with mounting brackets for simple storage.



SB Rescue Hook is a high-quality rescue hook, developed for efficient and safe recovery in the water. It is also fully compatible with the SB boat hook and is an indispensable tool for rescuers, lifeguard teams and others working in water rescue.

The user-friendly design and anti-slip grip make the hook safe and comfortable to handle. The integrated retro-reflective tape provides extra visibility during night operations or low-light situations where visibility is poor. By mounting the hook on the SB pole, the rescuer can quickly and efficiently retrieve a person from the water and guide them towards a rescue net, ladder or ladder - without having to go in themselves.

Protective Cover & Stowage



The SB Rescue Sling PVC Storage Bag is designed to protect the frame and harness while keeping the system mounted and ready for immediate use.

Made from durable 520 gsm PVC, it shields the equipment from weather and helps reduce wear when stored in exposed areas. The bag features a strong Velcro closure and three access flaps, allowing it to be used alongside the SB Rescue Sling Mounting Kit so the system remains securely mounted, protected, and easy to reach in an emergency.

Eyelet holes around the bottom edges of the bag allow water to drain freely, preventing trapped water that could damage the SB Rescue Sling or the bag itself and helping keep the system in good condition.
